HISTORY

Chincha Alta, Peru, was rocked by back-to-back 7.9 and 8.1 earthquakes in August 2007. In Chincha alone, 40,000 homes fell. Today, less than 10% have been rebuilt. Thousands of families still live in “esteras” made of woven reeds. An estera does not lock, and it will not keep wind and cold out in the winter, heat out in the summer, or vermin off the children at night.



EFCA Crisis Response is helping the elderly, single mothers, and families with infants and toddlers build homes in three communities on the outskirts of Chincha. Building homes is a ministry of obedience and compassion, but our real purpose is to reach people for Jesus. Several Bible studies and a youth group have been established, and there is a budding church plant that meets on Sunday afternoons.

God is at work in Chincha! Will you join Him in this long-term recovery effort?
