

Haiti Ministry Plan Overview

Vision:

to see an indigenous, disciple-making, and multiplying church, within walking distance of every Haitian, which demonstrates and engages in proclaiming the transforming power of the Gospel

We desire this Vision to be expressed through:

1. Tangible change towards a Biblical worldview in individuals, families, communities, churches, society, and the nation.
2. Port-au-Prince and surrounding areas becoming an equipping and sending center influencing 1,000,000 people with the Gospel.
3. Pastors and lay church leaders being multiplied (developed, empowered, and released).
4. A Haitian church impacting the world.

Mission:

to assist the Haitian church in reaching its people through the holistic presentation of the Gospel so that followers of Jesus become active in a healthy, disciple-making, multiplying church in Haiti and around the world.

Key Result Areas –

1. Restoration - The local church in Haiti was significantly impacted by the earthquake. We will partner with national church movements, local churches and ministry partners to help bring healing to the Body and to help restore and expand ministry capacity.
2. Leadership Development – The earthquake changed the physical landscape, but also the spiritual landscape. Many leaders died in the earthquake, and many people came to faith in the aftermath. We will partner with national church movements and local churches to help them identify, develop, empower and release the next generation of Haitian leaders.
3. Gospel Transformation – Approximately 30% of Haitians have a belief in Jesus, yet there is significant brokenness in most all aspects of life. For example, unemployment and illiteracy are both well over 50%. We will identify and come alongside movement leaders and ministry partners with a vision to bring Gospel transformation and reconciliation to change Haitian culture through the local church. This will include a holistic approach, seeking integral Great Commission and Great Commandment ministry in all we do.
4. Missions Mobilization – Haitians can have a significant impact on world evangelization. And as the nations have come to Haiti in response to the earthquake, those same nations, working together with Haitians can bring great things to world evangelization and for Gospel transformation in Haiti. We will seek to partner with Haitian ministries seeking to reach the world, and with international partners sharing the above vision for Haiti.

To accomplish these Key Results, and in recognition of the complexity of the ministry environment in Haiti, we will work through a variety of levels of partner interactions.
