Now close your eyes and imagine your student's artwork displayed in the Salt Lake Convention Center. Here's an opportunity for them to offer back to God their gift in ministry at Challenge 2008.

- ✓ All Art will be based on the "Sojourn" theme
- ✓ New category added: five-minute film shorts

Follow these four easy steps to help make their dream become reality!

- 1) Download the Visual Arts Show Participant's Form as a PDF from the Challenge website and have them fill it out completely. Have them also fill out the information section on copies of the evaluation form prior to the Visual Arts Show. (3 copies per medium/project shown)
- 2) Email the National Coordinator, at dale.lewis@efca.org and let him know the student's name, grade, church and which mediums they plan on participating in the Visual Arts Show. [Fine Art 2-D, Fine Art 3-D, Graphics, Visual Aids, Textiles, Photography and Film Shorts]

****Limit of five pieces of artwork per student/delegate.
Limit of 1 film short per student/group of students.***

- 3) Help them remember to bring their art with their participant's form to Salt Lake City and have them drop it off in the registration line on Sunday, June 29. [It's okay for them to come in and help you carry all the Challenge stuff back to your group]

****No last minute pen/pencil drawings will be accepted.
Presentation is very important in displaying your art.***

- 4) Don't let the students schedule any other activity for Wednesday, July 2 from 1- 4 pm. They'll be meeting with art professionals from the area who will fill out an evaluation and talk with each of them about their Visual Arts Show entries.
